I was born on April Fool's Day to two immigrants, a first-born child, and they admittedly didn't know what they were doing, as their families were in Israel and Australia. My dad was an entrepreneur/restaurant owner, and he worked 7 days a week, often 17 hour days.

My childhood was good, though I didn't see my dad except usually when we went for dinner at the restaurant. That being said, I didn't have him as a male figure/role model in my daily life, and I felt that lacking when I reached adolescence, when I met other boys who did. I grew up pretty much in a bubble and effeminate (to a certain extent), with strong emotions.

Had a major childhood trauma about age 7, as we all were involved (parents and younger brother) in a near-fatal car collision. I was the only one severely injured, requiring knee surgery and a lot of rehabilitation after. This injury caused me to develop a spiritual life early in life, as I really wondered about existence, God, etc.

I was named after Alexander the Great by my dad, and in many ways, my brother and I were subconsciously expected to play out his unfulfilled potential. My brother became a doctor (my dad's dream for himself), and I... bucked the system and didn't read "How to Win Friends and Influence People," and chose to rebel against him trying to mold me into a successful entrepreneur.

Instead of following my parents' path of conservatism (not just politically), I decided to be the spiritual seeker after reading The Celestine Prophecy. I read like a fish early on, and got into eastern philosophy and did a lot of traveling. After traveling the United States for 6 months in a car with a friend, I left for Israel and spent two and a half years studying Judaism, Torah, Kabbalah, etc. I became religious for a time, and thought I would get married and have a slew of children, even getting close to proposing to a girl in Israel after only 3 dates (not uncommon in the religious world).

But luckily, so often in life, weird hands of destiny or what have you would reach out and shake me at key points in my life. And I didn't get engaged or married, came back to the U.S. and we broke up. I left religion altogether, as I felt like even the rabbis were not people I wanted to emulate.

I came back, got my Master's in Psychology (which was my undergrad and a true passion). I should step back and say that I was an emotional mess throughout my 20's in that I was incredibly sensitive, and had major fits of anger and depression. My parents definitely wanted me on drugs, and I did see a therapist throughout my late 20's and into my 30's, but I never chose that route, as I felt like there was nothing wrong with me. My mantra: "I'm the only sane person in an insane world."

Got my MA degree, but decided not to use it. Didn't want to become a therapist. I tried being a Life Coach for about a year, and that was good but I couldn't deal with having to generate clients, and I started to feel inauthentic as a Coach--because I was faking it with my finances to pretend I was well off when I wasn't.

I didn't have sex until I turned 30. I was ruined by my RA in college who posted photos of STD's, and I'm thinking my virgo rising sign had me freaked the f out, and I thought women were out to kill me with their vaginas.

That eventually ended in my early 30's and I went on a sexual tear, having endless one night stands and a

few short relationships until I was about 38. Most of these came through dating apps. Then, finally, I had my first significant relationship (romantic). We dated for 2 1/2 years (my only other relationships were about 6 months each--maybe 3 of them). We even tried living together. I had a deep draw toward non-monogamy, but trying to communicate that somewhat destroyed our relationship, and we ended up breaking up, thankfully. Again, hand of destiny. On my birthday, met a woman at an art event who helped me see the light of how the relationship was slowly killing my soul.

Since that relationship almost ten years ago, I've had almost no relationships (romantically). I've also lost a lot of key friendships. I would say that early in life I called myself "a loner," and perhaps my identity got a little fixed on that. So, my blessing is my curse, making it difficult to leave!

I always journaled a ton, but it wasn't until a few years ago that I completed my first book and published it. Poetry and short stories. I've been a blogger for many years on psychology, relationships and spirituality. I also became a poker player about 5 or 6 years ago, and I've devoted about 40-50 hours a week (or more) to become a top level tournament poker player, having even played the World Series of Poker's Main Event in Vegas two summers ago.

Now, I'm pretty healthy (luckily), but spend a lot of my nights playing poker and my days at cafes drinking coffee, reading, and doing some writing (but often slacking and playing online games).

It should be said that I've probably got the Guinness Book of World Record for the greatest chronic masturbator. I've been a sex addict my whole life (but usually without a woman to share that with). I don't do one night stands anymore, not for years. I have done a great job on harnessing my emotions and my mind, and I would say (other than fits of rage at drivers), I'm pretty adept and mature w/r/t emotional intelligence.

I don't see myself wanting marriage or children, but I do crave/desire having a partner or many, but want to always have my own place to live; kinda need a sanctuary and I believe a part of me starts to die if I'm living with a woman. Die: as in, I get too comfortable.
